Guided by the process, Tanya came out of Road Ahead with a rough draft of a business plan to provide wellness resources to nurses on the front lines.

## SENIOR LEADERS TO ASK BETTER QUESTIONS AS THEY COME ALONGSIDE YOUNG PROFESSIONALS.

David, the CEO of a regional manufacturing business, came to one of our mentoring workshops. As he entered, he told our facilitator that he already mentored ten young people. Our facilitator joked that David should be teaching the workshop. But when the workshop ended, David said, "I cannot believe how many practical tools I got that I can use for asking better questions. I'm walking out with a different approach to the young professionals in my company."
